#### WHY SHOULD I LEARN MORSE CODE?



- It's Fun!
  - A rewarding skill with a strong community
- Low power & modest antenna offer Big Results!
- Works even in poor signal conditions
- It is the original operating mode of Ham Radio
  - Connection to the origins of radio communication



#### WHAT ARE WE SAYING IN MORSE CODE?



- Messages can be simple to conversational
- The Exchange
  - Short vs. Long
  - Often just a signal report and our location
    - POTA, SOTA, DX ...
- Standard QSO (Conversational)
  - 1st exchange: RST (signal report), QTH (location), Name
  - 2nd exchange: Rig (radio), Antenna, Weather
  - Ending: A polite goodbye

- 5. OK HW? AR

  (their call) DE (your call) K

### LICW TEACHING METHODS



Teaching methods <u>video</u>

#### THE LICW METHOD



- Character Introduction in the Koch Method (single letter)
- **№** 12 WPM
- Character sequence based on QSO Protocol
- Ensure characters heard as single acoustic sounds
- Establish character sound familiarity
- Character Recognition with focus on ICR/IER
  - Time to recognize and not dwelling on errors

#### **KIDS PROGRAM**



- Developed during COVID
- Small classes of 3-5 kids
  - One on one when needed
- Ages 5 to 17

- Adult curriculum modified for how kids learn
